As we look forward to 2023, we are optimistic that, with all hands on deck, the best is yet to come.

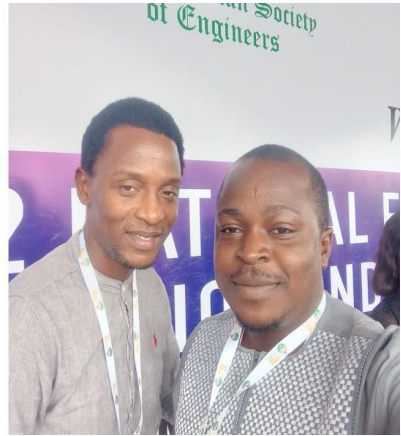
